What charging stations does Parkway have available?

Parkway has multiple electric vehicle charging stations available at the following locations:

Kimmel Center (300 S. Broad St.)	Liberty Place – 16 & Chestnut
8 th & Walnut Garage	30 th & JFK
12 th & Filbert Garage	Hanover East (339 N. Broad St)
12 th & Walnut Garage	Hanover West (322 N. Broad St)
9 th & Arch Lot	

How do I activate the charging station?

- To activate the electric vehicle charging station, a user must have a Blink card or a Chargepoint card – having both activation cards will assure ability to use all Parkway chargers
- To sign up for access cards go to www.blinkcharging.com and www.chargepoint.com

How much does it cost to use a station?

- At Parkway, charging your electric vehicle is a **FREE** amenity to our customers (1,2)
- The ChargePoint or Blink cards are simply used as a method to activate your charging session, your Blink or Chargepoint account will not be charged while using a Parkway Charger (2)

Can a user reserve a station?

- The stations are available on a first come/first served basis
- A user can go to the Blink or Chargepoint website to see if electric vehicle stations are available or being used

(1) Parkway reserves the right to change its Electric Vehicle policy at any time. Electric vehicle parking customers still adhere to facility's posted parking rates.

(2) The Blink network does allow a user to access the machine as a guest without an access card. However, Blink will charge the user's credit card \$2/hour.
